

A Deeper Glory

- 1st: Getting a revelation Jesus brought out concerning New Testament worship
- **Please Read: John 4:21-24**
- 1Tim 2:8, *"I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing."*
- Ephesians 5:18, *"Speak to one another with Psalms, hymns and spiritual songs"* – Col. 3:16

Hebrews 13:15-16, "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise — the fruit of lips that confess his name. And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased." *New Testament Sacrifices!*

Romans 12:1, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God — this is your spiritual act of worship."

1 Peter 2:5, "You also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ."

- New Temple that God now dwells through the Holy Spirit; Both individually and collectively
- 2nd: Consecration and separation from the world- being Holy as God is Holy- 1 Peter 1:16
- **Please Read: 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1** *2 Tim.2:21- 'If a man cleanses himself from the'*
- 3rd: Having a holy awe, respect and reverence for God's presence in manifestation

Hebrews 12:28-29

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our "God is a consuming fire."

- What does it mean to be reverent in God's presence when we gather together as a church?
 - o When the Holy Spirit is manifesting in our: Worship, Spiritual Gifts & Altar call
- That is not the time to get up from our seat and move around or talk- being a distraction
- 1Th.5:20, *"Do not retreat prophecies with contempt"*- to dismiss, disregard - take for granted

Ephesians 4:30

"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption."

- When the Spirit of God is moving, that's the time to be quiet and listen intently
- Fiddling on our phone (unless it's reading the Bible) is disrespectful of God's presence
- None of us wants to be stumbling block to others or hinder the Holy Spirit from ministering
- We never know what desperate needs folks have; counting on the anointing to break yoke

Our God is an Awesome God

- The Lord is preparing us for a deeper move of His glory- Lk. 3:16- Baptized with Spirit & Fire
- **Please Read:** 2 Chronicles 5:1, 4-6, 11-14

Hebrews 12:28-29, “Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our “God is a consuming fire.”

- **Please Read:** Isaiah 6:1-8

Daniel 7:9-10

As I looked, “thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His clothing was as white as snow; the hair of his head was white like wool. His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him. Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him. The court was seated, and the books were opened.”

Ezekiel 1:26-28

Above the expanse over their heads was what looked like a throne of sapphire, and high above on the throne was a figure like that of a man. I saw that from what appeared to be his waist up he looked like glowing metal, as if full of fire, and that from there down he looked like fire; and brilliant light surrounded him. Like the appearance of a rainbow in the clouds on a rainy day, so was the radiance around him. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord. When I saw it, I fell facedown, and I heard the voice of one speaking.

Revelation 15:7-8

Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls filled with the wrath of God, who lives for ever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the temple until the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.

The Mountain of the Lord

Genesis 22:14, “So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide. And to this day it is said, ‘On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided.’” *Jerusalem- Isaac was offered as a sacrifice*

- **Please Read:** Exodus 19:1-20 Mount Sinai – preparing to meet with God- 1 Pet.2:9
- **Please Read:** Exodus 24:7-18 The Covenant is Confirmed & Moses with God
 - o Moses waited on God for seven days before the Lord spoke to Him
- Isaiah 2:3, “Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord”- get with God in His presence
- **Please Read:** Hebrews 12:18-24 We have come to Mt Zion- throne access- Heb. 4:14-16

- Luke 5:16, *“But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.”*
- Jesus was in constant fellowship with the Father. We too need to seek God & get His plan

John 12:49, “For I did not speak of my own accord, but the Father who sent me commanded me what to say and how to say it.”

Luke 6:12-13, “One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. When morning came, he called his disciples to him and chose twelve of them, whom he also designated apostles...”

- Moses received precise instructions from the Lord- in constructing the tabernacle

Hebrews 8:5

They (Priests) serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven. This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: “See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain.” *Exodus 25:40*

- **Please Read: Exodus 40:16- 33**
- Mentioned 8 times: “Moses did everything as the Lord commanded him”
- **Please Read: Exodus 40:34-38**
- When we wait on God, spend time in His presence and get His plan and obey it- greater glory

Show me your glory

- **Please Read: Exodus 33:7-34:10** Moses received a new set of tablets
- **Please Read: Exodus 34:29-35** Glory on Moses’ face

Acts 6:15-7:1, “All who were sitting in the Sanhedrin looked intently at Stephen, and they saw that his face was like the face of an angel.”

- **Please Read: 2 Corinthians 3:1-18** We have a greater glory than that of Moses
- When Jesus told them to roll away the stone of Lazarus’s tomb- Martha- 4 days- stinketh

John 11:40

“Then Jesus said, ‘Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?’”

- The Lord is preparing us for a deeper move of His glory and grace
- Ps 127:1, *“Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain.”*
- Let’s get in God’s presence individually/corporately via prayer and praise- minister to Him
- Wait on the Lord, get the mind of the Lord, His plan and will for our church & this land
- Then faithfully obey and pursue His directions and leading with all our hearts
